S1	As a salesperson I want the system to work for courses in which the course grade is the weighted total of an arbitrary number of categories so that it can be used for more courses offered by one of our current customers.	<input type="checkbox"/> The system displayed the correct output for a course with six categories with no dropped grades <input type="checkbox"/> The system displayed the correct output for a course with five categories, one of which drops the lowest and one of which drops the highest and lowest.
S2	As an administrator, I want the summary grade for a category to continue to be the total of the grades on the assessments in that category in order to keep the system simple.	<input type="checkbox"/> The system displayed the correct output for all system tests from the previous sprint.
S3	As an administrator I want the categories and the assessments that comprise them to be contained in a file that is read by the system so that I can create grading rules for different courses.	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> There is a document describing the file format <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> There is an example file.
