

## Specifications: LeafScore

In addition to the obvious specifications illustrated in the UML class diagram, the LeafScore class must satisfy the following specifications.

- 1. LeafScore objects must be immutable.
- 2. If a constructor is passed a key that is null or empty (i.e., "") then the constructor must throw an IllegalArgumentException.
- 3. The LeafScore(String key) constructor must construct a LeafScore object with a value attribute of 0.0.
- 4. The parseLeafScore() method (is a factory method that) must throw an IllegalArgumentException if the key is null or empty, or if the value does not represent a valid double.
