



Specifications: Course

A Course object contains information about all of the categories of graded assessments in a course. For example, a typical Computer Science Course object might consist of the categories “Programming Assignments”, “Homeworks”, “Mid-Term Exam”, and “Final Exam”. In addition to the obvious specifications illustrated in the UML class diagram, the Course class must satisfy the following specifications.

1. Course objects must be immutable.
2. The constructor must "store" aliases of its arguments.
