

## **Specifications: Course**

A Course object contains information about all of the categories of graded assessments in a course. For example, a typical Computer Science Course object might consist of the categories "Programming Assignments", "Homeworks", "Mid-Term Exam", and "Final Exam". In addition to the obvious specifications illustrated in the UML class diagram, the Course class must satisfy the following specifications.

- 1. Course objects must be immutable.
- 2. The constructor must "store" aliases of its arguments.
